

Youth Leader: Byron United Church

Background:

We are a Christ-centered, evangelical, mainline congregation in the west end of London. The majority of our members are retired and white, but we have an increasing number of young families joining us, many of whom are from India and Africa. At minimum, we are looking for a Sunday morning Youth Leader (5 hours/week), and at maximum, we are looking for someone for both Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings (10 hours/week).

Sunday worship begins at 10:00 AM, and concludes between 11:00-11:15 AM.

Wednesday Youth begins at 6:30 PM, and concludes at 8:00 PM.

The Wednesday youth time includes dinner together, Christian discussion, gym games.

Position Summary: The new Youth Leader will plan and lead our Sunday morning youth and co-lead our Wednesday evening youth in cooperation with other Wednesday youth co-leaders. Specific responsibilities are listed below. The Senior Pastor will be responsible for overall supervision.

Detailed Position Description:

- Provide weekly Christian-focused lessons and games for youth on Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings.
- Send periodic messages to parents (current themes, upcoming events, etc.)
- Work with the Senior Pastor to coordinate special Sundays when youth are upstairs during worship (special Christmas, Easter, etc. events)
- Coordinate "All-Grades" events with the Sunday School & Youth Coordinator and other leaders
- Recruit occasional volunteers to participate (i.e., actors for skits, guest speakers, etc.)
- Source, gather and set up materials for each week's lessons
- Clean up the classrooms and/or gym after each session
- Create and update weekly attendance sheets
- Submit receipts to the church office to be reimbursed for supplies purchased, etc.
